
The World During the Age of Discovery Map (Text, pg. 85)

- 3. Use matching colors or patterns to indicate exploration routes taken by Magellan, Dias, Columbus, Vasco de Gama, Cartier and Hudson. Remember the 1494 Line of Demarcation is shown on the map.
- 4. Create a 'Key' somewhere indicating colors and countries
- 5. Besides de Gama, who explored for Portugal?
- 6. Which explorers sailed around (not just to) the southern tip of Africa?
- 7. Why was Portugal the leader in the voyages of exploration?
