Columbian Exchange Restaurant Menu

Instructions: After you have identified on your map the locations of the various foods and consumables, it is your task to create a restaurant menu that reflects the Columbian Exchange. Your project should demonstrate your understanding of everything that was a part of this exchange, but also the legacies of this monumental transformation in community and exchange beginning in the 15th century.

Your menu must include the following:

- Restaurant must have a name
- Two breakfast items
- Two lunch items
- Two dinner items
- Two desserts
- Two beverages

Each dish you list must also include **key** ingredients (those you located on the map), and must represent the combination of both Eastern (Old World) and Western (New World) Hemisphere foods. On the front of the menu, list the items and price, while on the back, provide a breakdown of the primary ingredients.
